**EIGHTH SESSION OF THE MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE ON FISHERIES COOPERATION AMONG AFRICAN STATES BORDERING THE ATLANTIC OCEAN  
Accra (Ghana), 17-19 February 2010**

**FINAL REPORT**

1/ The Ministerial Meeting of the eighth Session of the Ministerial Conference on Fisheries Cooperation between African States Bordering the Atlantic Ocean (ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT), took place in Accra (Ghana) on 19 February 2010, at the kind invitation of the Government of the Republic of Ghana. It was preceded by the meeting of Experts which took place on 17/18 February 2010 in Accra.

2/ Taking part in the meeting were the Ministers and representatives of the following member States: Angola, Benin, Cameroon, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea-Bissau, Ivory Coast, Liberia, Morocco, Mauritania, Nigeria, Senegal, Sierra Leone and Togo, as well as the subsidiary networks of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT, i.e. the African Network of Fisheries and Marine Science Research Institutes (RAFISMER) and the African Maritime Training Establishments Network (REFMA).

3/ The following observers were also present at the meeting: Exchange South-South (ESS), Japan, regional and international organizations as well as the following institutions:

- Overseas Fishery Cooperation Foundation (OFCF) of Japan;
- United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO);
- Intergovernmental Organization for Information and Cooperation on Marketing and Fisheries Products in Africa (INFOPÊCHE), and
- Sub-regional Fisheries Committee of West Central Gulf Of Guinea (FCWC/CPCO).

4/ A list of the participants is attached.

5/ The opening ceremony was presided by His Excellency the Honorable KWESI AHWOI, Minister of Food and Agriculture of the Republic of Ghana.

6/ In his address, His Excellency the Honorable KWESI AHWOI, expressed his deep gratitude to the Kingdom of Morocco and the Government of Japan for their financial assistance in organizing this session. He expressed his gratitude to all participants, in the name of the President of the Republic of Ghana, Prof. John Atta Mills Hails and the people of Ghana, and thanked them for having chosen to organize this session in Ghana, the first time since the creation of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT in 1989 that an English-speaking nation has been selected.

7/ Furthermore, he recalled the challenges to be faced by ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT, in particular:

- The rise in the number of jobs available in the fisheries sector;
- The increase in income received from international trade;
- The large contribution made by the fisheries sector to the GDP of member countries
- Food safety
- Reducing poverty

8/ He urged the Conference to adopt the documents giving ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT legal personality so it can play its full part at the international level, i.e.:

- Amended protocol regarding the institutional framework of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT
- Financial rules
- Internal rules of procedure
- Status of staff
- Financial contribution to the Regional Fisheries Development Fund (FRDP)

9/ Finally, he declared open the eighth Session of the Ministerial Conference on Fisheries Cooperation between African States Bordering the Atlantic Ocean.

### **SIGNATURE OF THE AMENDED PROTOCOL REGARDING THE INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK OF ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT**

10/ Two versions of the amended protocol, English and French, were submitted to the delegations for signature.

## **REPORT BY THE OUTGOING PRESIDENT OF ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT**

13/ The representative of the outgoing President presented a statement of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT's activities for the period 2007-2009, in which he noted the action taken as a follow-up to the decisions and recommendations of the 7<sup>th</sup> session. The report as presented furnished detailed information on the activities carried out.

14/ The report of the outgoing President was considered satisfactory by all the participants and was therefore adopted unanimously.

## **STUDY AND ADOPTION OF THE REPORT OF THE MEETING OF EXPERTS**

15/ The meeting of experts took place in Accra, Ghana on 17-18 February 2010. At the end of its work the meeting adopted a report which included the results of its debates as well as its recommendations concerning the various subjects discussed.

16/ The Conference studied this report attentively and made appropriate comments on its contents.

## **REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARIAT OF ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT**

17/ The Conference took note of the report of its activities and expressed its satisfaction at the results achieved by the Executive Secretariat, despite the limited resources at its disposal. It recommended that this report be completed by the addition of information about the rate of achievement of each activity.

## **STUDY OF DOCUMENTS CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARIAT OF ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT**

18/ Three documents were submitted for examination: the planned Internal Rules of Procedure regarding the organization and operation of the Executive Secretariat of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT, the proposed status of the staff of the Executive Secretariat and the planned Financial Rules.

19/ The Internal Rules regarding the organization and operation of the Executive Secretariat were examined, amended and adopted.

20/ The planned Financial Rules document was amended and adopted. However, the Conference recommended it to be completed with a manual of procedure written by a consultant and then submitted by the Executive Secretary to a work group. However, Mauritania expressed reserve about Article 2 of the Financial Rules as adopted.

21/ As for the planned Status of staff, the Conference recommended that this plan should be completed by the Executive Secretariat, particularly the items regarding evaluation criteria and procedures, pay and allowances, etc., and submitted afterward to the work group mentioned in paragraph 17 to study the Manual of Procedure.

Elsewhere, differences were raised about the question concerning the recruitment of Secretariat staff. Several countries wanted recruitment of staff to the Secretariat of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT, especially unit managers who are career officials, to be open to nationals of member States. The position of Morocco is that, in accordance

with the Convention, the Kingdom of Morocco finances the operations of the Executive Secretariat and supplies its own staff.

22/ Recommendation was made to set up a work group to study the status of staff as well as the manual of procedure.

The work group is composed of Ivory Coast, Ghana, Mauritania, Nigeria, Angola, Cameroon, Guinea-Bissau and Morocco. This group will make recommendations that aim at harmonizing all the documents of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT so as to offer more opportunities to nationals of all member countries. The meeting will take place in Morocco. Traveling expenses are to be the responsibility of each country..

### **ESTABLISHMENT OF THE REGIONAL FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT FUND (FRDP)**

23/ The system of fair sharing and a fixed base amount of US\$10,000 as the annual contribution to the Fisheries Development Fund (FRDP) was adopted.

### **PRESENTATION OF THE REPORT OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING THE FUND FOR PROMOTING FISHING IN THE ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT AREA**

24/ The Conference took note of the first meeting of the Joint Committee held in Accra, Ghana, on 15/16 February 2010 and was pleased to learn that the Fund would soon be functioning, and that it would certainly strengthen the activities of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT in member States.

### **PRESENTATION OF ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT'S THREE-YEAR PROGRAMME OF ACTIVITIES**

25/ The Conference took note of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT's three-year programme of activities for the period 2010-2012. This plan consists of five areas of action. (Cf. Copy attached).

26/ The Conference recommended that an order of priority should be established for carrying out these actions, top priority being given to the protection and preservation of fisheries resources primarily by means of the creation of a regional plan for combating illegal fishing and the establishment of a network for interchange between analytical laboratories of fisheries products.

27/ It also asked for another column to be added to the table, showing the financial contributions of each party.

## **REINFORCEMENT OF WOMEN'S ACTIVITIES IN THE FISHERIES SECTOR OF MEMBER STATES OF ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT**

27/ The Conference recommended that women should be encouraged to form groups in each country so as to create a network of top-rank organizations on the scale of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT.

### **ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT'S INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION STRATEGY**

28/ The Conference acknowledged the importance of the ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT's website as a rapid and efficient means of spreading and exchanging information between member states, and recommended countries that had yet to do so to designate focal points as soon as possible.

### **PLACE AND DATE FOR THE NINTH SESSION**

29/ It was decided that Angola should organize the 9<sup>th</sup> session of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT and the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Bureau.

### **OTHER BUSINESS**

30/ In his presentation, the representative of the delegation of Japan informed the meeting of the 15th Session of the CITES conference to be held in March at Doha (Qatar), and of Monaco's proposal to add the Atlantic red tuna to Appendix I of CITES, to be studied at CITES . COP15.

31/ He noted that the addition of the Atlantic red tuna to Appendix I of CITES could damage the sustainable use of this species.

32/ The same applies to the addition to Appendix II of CITES, of eight species of shark and valuable coral.

33/ He asked for the support of member States of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT for the position of Japan, which is that this issue be removed from CITES and placed in the hands of organizations entrusted with the task of managing these species, such as ICCAT. The meeting expressed its support for the Japanese position which remains faithful to the principles of the sustainable use of fisheries resources.

34/ In his presentation, Mr. BABANA Ould Yahya, Vice-president of REFMA, presented his report on the results of the activities of this network and its Action Plan for the next two years.

35/ The Representative of RAFISMER Mr. SAID TALEB presented an account of the activities of this network and its action plan for 2010-2012.

36/ The meeting was advised that INFOPÊCHE was holding an extraordinary meeting in addition to the Ministerial Conference of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT.

### **STATEMENTS BY HEADS OF DELEGATIONS AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS**

37- The Conference heard statements by the Heads of Delegation from member States of Cameroon, Senegal, Morocco, Guinea-Bissau and Gambia.

### **READING AND ADOPTION OF THE REPORT**

38/ The Conference adopted this report including the statements and recommendations it contains. It also requested the permanent Secretariat to prepare and distribute a definitive version.

### **CLOSE OF THE MEETING**

39/ H.E. the Honorable NII AMASAH NAMOALE, Ghanaian Vice-Minister of Fishing and Agriculture, President of ATLAFCO/COMHAFAT, announced the close of the 8th session of the Ministerial Conference on Fisheries Cooperation between African States Bordering the Atlantic Ocean

The meeting was declared closed at 8 pm on 19 February 2010.
