



PROPOSED ToR FOR REGIONAL DIALOGUES DECODING THE EU SFPAs WITH AFRICA

Access to SFPA data by stakeholders and role in decision-making

- Promoting stakeholders' participation on the identification of priorities for use of funds of sectoral support.
- Engaging stakeholders in the dialogues of technical and mixed committees meetings
- Making public and open to consultation the information on “ex ante” and “ex post” evaluations of SFPAs – assessing strengths and weaknesses

Implementation: Transparency and accountability of coastal states authorities and fishing operators

- Transparency of fishing activities: role of fishing agents, catch documentation schemes and reports on catches and discards
- Performance assessment on implementation of SFPAs: development of objective criteria and indicators

Scientific evaluation of stocks – determination of surplus

- Improving quality science and biology of target and by catch species
- Prioritise focus on stocks by importance / volumen of catches?
 - Migratory stocks: tropical tuna and sharks
 - Cephalopods
 - Demersal and Deep-sea

- Zonation between industrial fishing / artisanal fishers
- Real-time / seasonal closed areas to protect juveniles and or spawning aggregations
- MPAs
